- You are a passionate and experienced rider that is comfortable riding BC-style trails and terrain.

- Experience guiding groups of all abilities and know how to tailor teaching materials to different age groups.
- Excellent people skills competent, friendly, outgoing and upbeat.
- Organized, responsible, dependable, self-motivated, and attentive to detail.
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Strong guest service skills.
- Ability to maintain a physical position that requires grasping, standing, repetitive motions, lifting, listening as well as hearing ability, and visual acuity.
